She was born Aug 28, 1948 in Wabash to Armin L and Irma A (Rudig) Bahler.

Surviving with her parents are one sister and four brothers. Mrs Donald (Marilyn) Pries, Kokomo, Wallace A Bahler, Fort Wayne, Stanley L Bahler, Cincinnati, Ohio, Nelson E Bahler, Cape Giraradeau, MO, and Alan Bahler, Baytown, Texas.
