Samuel Rodegap's Obituary

1933, Goshen, Indiana

Samuel Rodegap, 88, died at his home one mile north of Goshen at 4:30 o'clock this morning after a six month illness of a complication of ailments. The deceased was **born in Jefferson township on April 25, 1844 the son of Isaac and Mary Rodegap**. He has spent his entire life, with the exception of about one year, in Jefferson township.

In 1872 he was married to Fanny Miller who survives him. On August 18th of last year the couple celebrated their sixtieth wedding anniversary.

Surviving, besides the widow, are **two daughters, Mrs. Lillian Long of Goshen, and Mrs. Lorena Ganger of Elkhart; one sister, Mrs. Jennie James of Richmond, Mo.**, 5 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

The body was taken to the Stiver Funeral home where friends may view the remains until 10 o'clock Thursday morning when the body will be returned to the home. Funeral services will be held at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the home and at two o'clock at the West Side Church of the Brethren of which the deceased was a member. The Rev. William Hess and the Rev. Samuel Miller will officiate. Burial will be made in the West Side cemetery. It is requested that no flowers be sent.
